

# 2021 COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic Experience Survey Results



**Background:** Durham Region Health Department conducted an online survey of Durham Region residents vaccinated for COVID-19 at a Health Department or Lakeridge Health clinic between April and October 2021. The results provide a snapshot of the client experience at that time.

## How was the clinic experience?

16,516 people completed the survey



• **Very satisfied with their overall clinic experience.**



- Satisfied with safety measures at the clinic.
- Found the clinic location easy to get to and received the help they needed.
- Reported clinic set-up made it easy to know where to go.



- Reported wait time was about what they expected or shorter.
- Found it was easy to book their appointment.

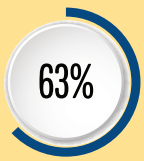


- Reported clinic wait time and travel time to be 20 minutes or less.

8,020 respondents provided open-ended comments about their experience.

- 98% of the comments were positive or complimentary.
- 560 comments contained constructive feedback.

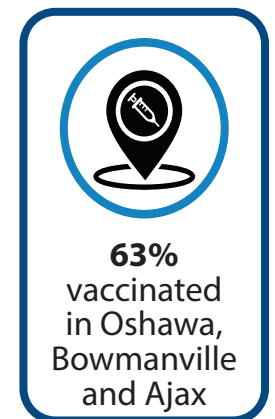
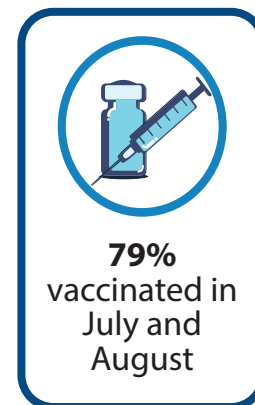
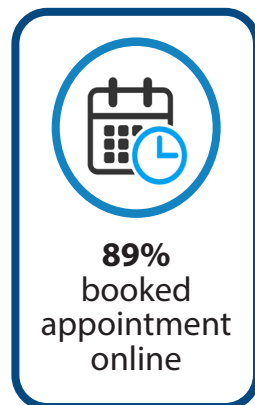
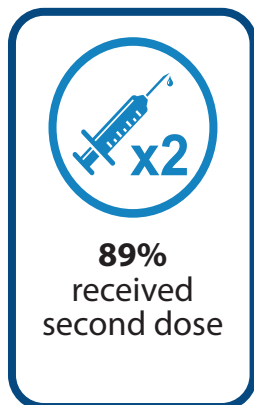
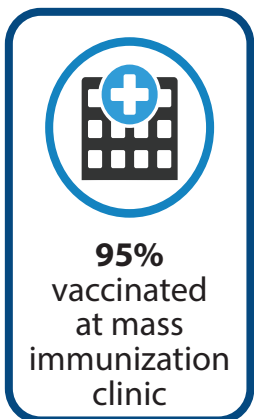
